COVID PROTOCOL RECOMMENDATIONS September 1, 2022

SGUUF Board of Trustees

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The Board met recently to review the March 22, 2022, recommendations from the Re-Opening Task Force. The report was presented to the Board at the August meeting. Discussions and voting took place over the next two meetings. Below are the final recommendations from the Board.

<u>Masks:</u> MASKS WILL BE OPTIONAL for indoor/outdoor gatherings.

Self-Reporting:

Those in attendance at an in-person event who receive a positive Covid test within 2 weeks after an event are encouraged to notify the Board President at president@sangabrieluu.org as soon as possible. This allows for the communication to the Fellowship through email and on the website. The identification of the person making the report will be anonymous unless they give permission to publish their name.

Safety Messaging:

An announcement regarding how to self-report to be made at the beginning of each activity.

RE and Nursery:

Masking at the discretion of the RE Leader/Volunteer or guardians.

Singing:

Allowed without masks

Check-in and Contact Tracing:

Eliminated for now

Notifications indicating a change in recommendations:

The Board is committed to tracking the CDC website on a weekly basis regarding Williamson County Covid rates. If there is an uptick in cases, the Board will ask the Administrator to update the website and send an email to the Fellowship with the necessary changes.

Level Low - masks optional

Level Medium - masks required

Level High – Online services only/no in person services
